

FAST TRACK 2025

Energy Infrastructure Incentives for Zero-Emission (EnergiZE) Commercial Vehicles provides reimbursement-style grants for zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) infrastructure equipment for medium-duty and heavy-duty (MDHD) battery-electric and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles in California.

EnergiZE Fast Track 2025 incentives support the construction of public, private, or shared MDHD ZEV charging or hydrogen fueling stations.



INCENTIVE STRUCTURE

Infrastructure Type	Maximum Per Charger Port / Hydrogen Dispenser Incentive Amount	Equity Per Charger Port / Hydrogen Dispenser Incentive Amount (+25%)	Maximum Award Per Project
≤50 kW EV Port	\$25,000	\$31,250	\$3 million (\$3.75 M for equity)
51–150 kW EV Port	\$75,000	\$93,750	
151–350 kW EV Port	\$150,000	\$187,500	
≥351 kW EV Port	\$300,000	\$375,000	
Hydrogen Dispenser	\$2 million	\$2.5 million	\$4 million (\$5 M for equity)

Incentives may cover up to but not more than 100 percent of per item costs. Equity criteria are defined in the Implementation Manual.

ELIGIBLE COSTS

Eligible costs include but are not limited to:



EV EQUIPMENT

- Level 2 chargers
- Direct current fast chargers (DCFC)
- Transformers
- Switchgear, meter mains, and circuit breaker panels



HYDROGEN EQUIPMENT

- Dispenser with hose and nozzles
- Hydrogen storage
- Compressors



SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE WARRANTY



REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY

Fast Track 2025 applications will be primarily scored on project readiness (Readiness Tiers), with additional points available for publicly available or shared stations and projects that demonstrate significant community support. Not all documents listed below are required for every Tier.

- Site Verification Form
- Final Site Design or Preliminary Site Plans
- Issued Building Permit or Submitted Building Permit Application
- Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) Permitting Checklist (EV only)
- Formal Charger Equipment Quote (EV only)
- Formal Hydrogen Dispenser Quote (H2 only)
- Formal Hydrogen Storage Equipment Quote (H2 only)
